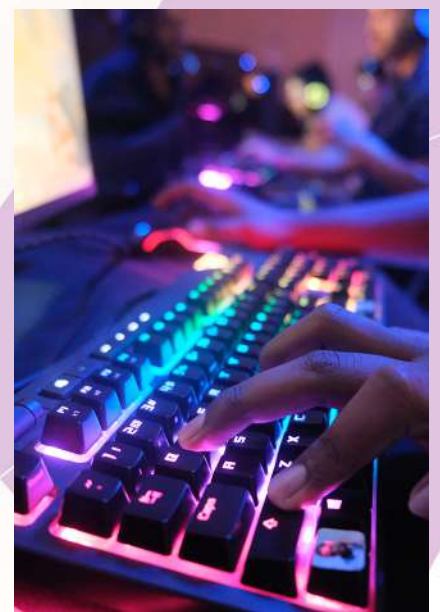
# Cultural - Day 3

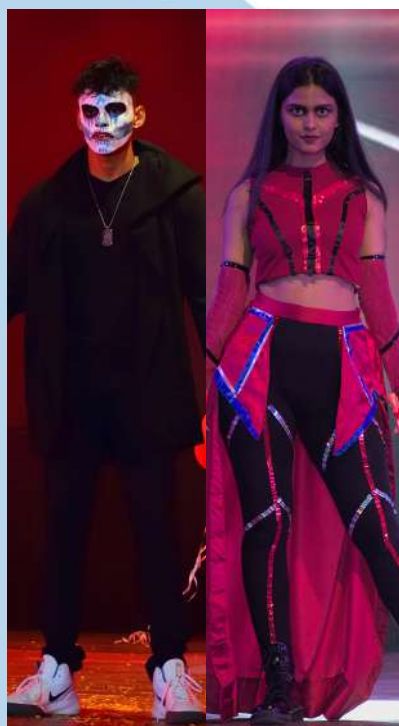


# Cultural - Day 4

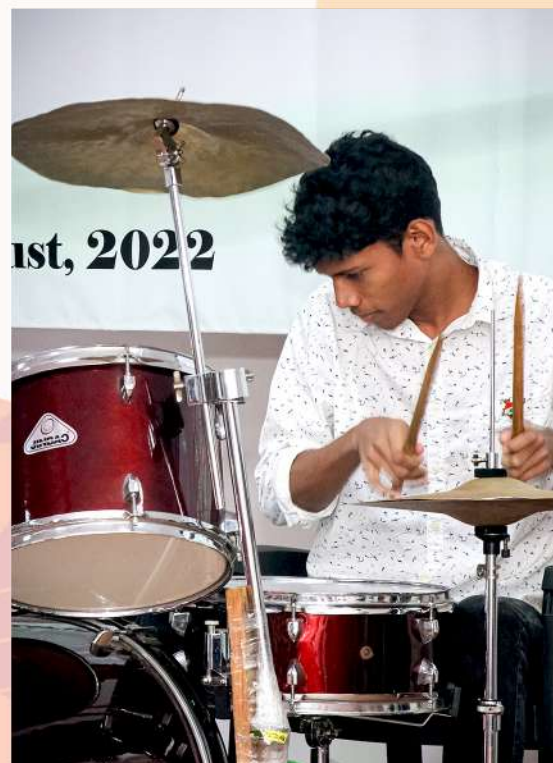




# Independence Day
