2. ****AI-Expedition Workshop****:

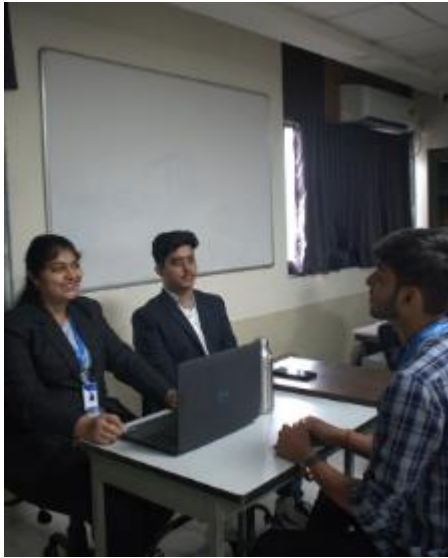
- An immersive workshop on AI and ML, covering history, types, ethics, and future advancements, attracting over 100 students.

- Students competed in Battle Grounds Mobile India, showcasing strategic skills and teamwork, fostering camaraderie.

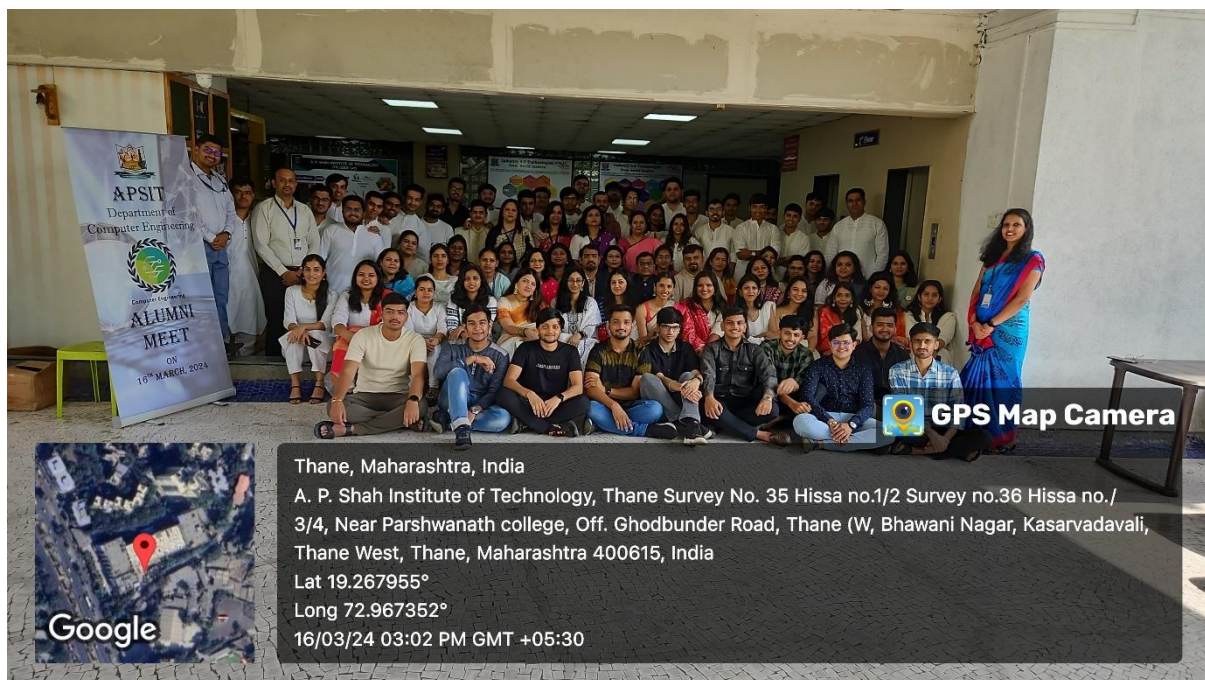
Exalt provided a platform for learning, collaboration, and fun, highlighting technological passion and creativity.
